Awards and Sales

- *All paintings must be for sale.
- *A commission of 30% will be paid to **STAA** when your painting is sold.
- * Awards will be selected at the discretion of the juror as follows:
Best of Show (\$250)
Award of Excellence (\$100)
Award of Exceptional Merit (\$100)
Presidents' Award (\$100)
Milford Zornes Memorial Award (\$100)
Mini Award of Excellence (\$50)
Purchase Award (determined by the painting & selected by Gayle Higgins Jones)

Eligibility The juried exhibition of original, waterbased media on paper is open to 2008 members of the Louisiana Watercolor Society. Paintings must be unvarnished and executed in the **past three years** without instructor supervision. Paintings must be matted in white, off-white or light gray.. Frames must have screw-eyes and wire. Paintings previously shown in LWS Shows may be submitted if they have not won an award. Mini paintings are not to exceed 8"x 10" glass size (or 36" sum total for all 4 sides of the glass). Minis must be matted and wired.

Entry Procedure

- *2008 Dues must be paid.
- * The show will be selected from slide or jpeg entries on a CD. Label entries as follows: Last Name, First Name, Title of Painting, Image Size.
- *You may submit up to 3 original paintings and 3 original mini-paintings. (6 paintings total)
- *No prints, giclees or copies of copyrighted photos
- *Paintings previously shown in LWS Shows may be submitted if they have not won an award.

Fees: \$10 for one entry; **\$20** for 2 or 3 entries.
Entry fee will not be refunded. For every regular painting entered, you can add a mini-painting for the mini price of \$1. Example: \$11 for one mini & one regular; \$23 for 3 regulars and 3 minis.
* If you enter only minis, the fee is **\$10** for one entry; **\$20** for 2 or 3 entries.

Delivery: Accepted work that is not hand delivered must be shipped to STAA in reusable crates with shipping prepaid for return. STAA

Juror: Susan Copping is a native of New Orleans who lives on the North Shore of Lake Pontchartrain. Susan holds a B.A. in Art from the University of New Orleans and studied at the John McCrady Art School. Susan has been a watercolorist for the past thirty years. In that time she has developed a unique style of painting using geometric shapes and their spatial relationships to eloquently describe her favorite subjects: plant life, animals and the insect world. Her talent is held in high regard by her peers and she is a well-known and respected member of the local art community.

Susan worked for many years at Delgado Community College in New Orleans teaching design and color theory to her students and is currently teaching at Water Street Pottery. Susan is a member of the St. Tammany Art Association and a Signature Member of the Louisiana Watercolor Society. She is a past president of that organization and now serves on its Board of Directors.
